A Message from Pastor Melissa...

Dear Church.

Last week, I took my son to pick out his costume for trick or treating. He went through a few ideas over the last couple of weeks, but he finally settled on one and insisted that he was absolutely going to be a ninja for Halloween. With ninjas in mind, we went out to the Halloween store, and he carefully decided on a ninja costume that was black with blue dragon details. Don't be surprised if you see me walking through the grocery store with a ninja in tow, because the boy loves his costumes!

I have always enjoyed Halloween myself. There were many years when I dressed up like the wicked witch from Oz or a dalmatian like the 101 dalmatians. Year after year I would walk to my neighbor's houses and say "trick or treat" as they filled my little bucket with more candy than I would be allowed to eat between then and Christmas.

As an adult, I still enjoy Halloween, but the reason is a bit more nuanced. In modern trick or treating, I see a mass expression of grace, imitating in a very small way the grace of God. The grace of God is a free gift. We cannot earn it. No clothes we wear or good deeds we choose will earn us the love of God. 
