Dear Dunlap family and friends,

During this past week, I spent a few days with fellow Indiana United Methodist clergy learning about Breakthrough Prayer. The idea is that we believe that prayer makes a difference, so we will ask and expect that God is going to breakthrough any troubles to do transformative work in our church. The speaker we heard shared many stories where churches who have chosen to pray together for a period of time have seen God's incredible work in their church and world.

In our church, we are continuing on a path of discernment. What is the future of our church? Will this church remain United Methodist or disaffiliate to join another denomination? Where is God calling Dunlap today and in the future? On a more personal level, every person needs to make choices in the short and long term. In the short term, we are entering a season of stewardship, when we each have the opportunity to pledge what we will give in the coming year. In the long term, each individual needs to discern where and how we are called to serve God.

During the month of November, I want to invite every person to join me in the practice of Breakthrough Prayer, expecting that God will help each of us to discern our future path as individuals and as a church. The way this works is that in addition to your normal prayer time, once a day, every day, pray the words of Psalm 25:4-5. Set a timer on your phone, stick a note on your mirror, whatever works for you, but once a day, every day, let us all pray the same words. Let us ask God to breakthrough our fears, our inhibitions, and our worries to transform Dunlap United Methodist Church.
