It's Sign-up Time! For each event listed below, we need a team to make plans (set dates, plan menus, decide on themes, etc) and find volunteers to work at the event. During January, you will find sign-up sheets in the hall. Please take time to read the information and then spend some time in prayer to discern how God is calling you to help.

**Vacation Bible School:** a time when children can learn about Jesus through Bible stories, crafts, games, music, and snacks.

For many children who attend VBS, this is the only time they hear about God. This is a huge responsibility and an honor, that God allows us to serve Him by serving these children.

If you want proof that Vacation Bible School makes a difference, talk to Cathy (one of our preschool teachers). Last summer, we had a little boy who came to VBS. He had never been away from family members before, and he cried the entire first day. He cried the next day and the next. On Friday, he was finally able to smile occasionally, although he was still a bit shaky. He is enrolled in preschool now, and when Cathy mentions someone who needs prayer, he is the first one to step up and say "I want to pray." God is working in our church. Praise Him! Block Party: an opportunity to serve our community by sharing God's love with families and providing school supplies to children.

There are many people who are reluctant to come to any church event. Sometimes it's because they've had a bad experience in the past, for others it's fear of the unknown, for others it's the belief that church people are "holier-than-thou," etc, etc. When we invite people to come to church to share a meal, to play games, to do crafts or just to talk, we can break down those barriers. The Block Party is a non-threatening way to get people to the church, and hopefully open the door for relationships to grow.

Chicken Barbeque: a fund-raising event which allows us to have fellowship with one another and with members of the community.

Just like the Block Party, the chicken barbecue is a "safe" way for people to come to the church and meet church members. This gives people a chance to meet us and find out that "church" people are friendly and welcoming.

Women's Retreat: a time for women to come together and grow in faith.

Women love to talk, laugh, pray, and even cry together. Retreats can be serious or fun (or both), they can be boisterous or quiet, they can focus on study or center around a mission project. When women come together for a faith-based event, lives are transformed.
